

The speaker made a strong argument for women being a upholders of patriarchy and strong defenders of those who are involved in trafficking. She gave several instances from her personal experience that made the webinar interesting for the participants. The students were inquisitive about what happens on the ground level and wanted to know more from the speaker. They expressed their eagerness to know what they can do as a civilian and as a young adult to put a stop to trafficking in the country. One could see that they were sensitised towards the issue and were left better informed about it at the end of the webinar.
