Important functions of the IQAC: The main responsibility of the IQAC is to plan, navigate, facilitate and monitor various administrative and academic activities that are necessary to create learner-centric environment in the institution. The IQAC maintains quality standards in teaching, learning and evaluation. It also looks into collection of feedback from stakeholders, which is later analysed. Developing and maintaining database is also carried out time to time. Academic audit, administrative audit and gender audit are also carried out periodically. It also prepares and uploads the AQAR.

Major Activities organised:

1. Under Faculty Development Programme, a Talk on ‘New Career Advancement Scheme – API Rules was organised for degree college teachers by Dr. Debajit Sarkar, Principal on 6th July 2018.
2. English speaking course was organized for students by Teach India – Times of India, from July to September 2018, and from January to March 2019.
