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3. A Study of Secondary School Students' Attitude towards Education in Relation to their Educational Aspirations and Educational Resilience

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Abstract

Attitude towards education is the degree to which the students view the usefulness and need of education in one's life. Educational aspirations means students' thoughts about their future after school education, their goals and their confidence in achieving those goals. Educational Resilience is the degree to which students believe in their own ability to deal with problems and challenges that they face in their school settings. The present study aimed at comparing secondary school students' attitude towards education, educational aspirations and educational resilience on the basis of gender. It also aimed at finding out whether there exists any relationship between 'secondary school students' attitude towards education and educational aspirations' and 'secondary school students' attitude towards education and educational resilience'. The sample consisted of 110 secondary school students (63 boys and 47 girls). In order to collect data, attitude towards education scale by Thombare, V. (1993), educational aspirations scale and educational resilience scales by Shah, G. (2016) were used. The results of the present study revealed that there is no significant difference in secondary school students' attitude towards education, educational aspirations and educational resilience on the basis of gender. It also revealed that there exist positive and significant correlation between 'secondary school students' attitude towards education and educational aspirations' and 'secondary school students' attitude towards education and educational resilience'.

Introduction

"Education is the most powerful weapon which you can use to change the world"

.....Nelson

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The above quote by Nelson Mandela clearly brings out the importance of education in one's life. Therefore it is imperative for students to develop positive attitude towards education. Attitude towards education is the degree to which the students view the usefulness and need of education in one's life.

There is a difference between being a literate and being educated. Literacy mean ability to read and write, on the other hand education means to obtain knowledge to enhance one's ability to reason and make sound judgments. Education helps to make use of literacy for development of personality and train mind and abilities for the betterment of the society. If one looks at the present scenario of students do not know the difference between literacy and education. Students consider education as only attending school studying the subject taught in the school, doing homework and getting good grades and percentages so that they get better jobs in future. Good grades and percentages are important but at the same time one must realize the importance of productive life. Thus it becomes crucial for students to utilize the gain knowledge to enhance one's approach towards leading a meaningful and productive life.

The ability of students to ability to identify and set goals for the future is known as aspirations. Educational aspirations means students' thoughts about their future after school education, their goals and their confidence in achieving those goals. Coping plays an important role in one's psychological and physical well-being when one is confronted with stressful or negative life events (Jassat, 1997). Generally one's ability to cope well with difficulties and continue and adjust when things go awry is referred to by the word resilience. Educational Resilience in particular is the degree to which students believe in their own ability to deal with problems and challenges that they face in their school settings.

The present study tries to incorporate and relate these three variables i.e. attitude towards education, educational aspirations and educational resilience. Students with high educational aspirations and educational resilience will tend to have more positive attitude towards education and vice-versa.

Review of Related Literature

Wadikar, S. (2000) attempted to study the impact of modern environment on the attitude towards education of boys and girls belonging to different stages of adolescence. Study revealed that there is a significant difference in attitude towards education of boys and girls belonging to different stages of adolescence. Hussain, A. (2007) conducted a study to identify effect of guidance services on study attitudes, study habits and academic achievement of secondary school students. The result of the study indicated that the guidance services have significant effect on

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the students study attitudes, study habits and academic achievement. Results from studies on educational aspirations have emphasized the importance of efforts to enhance adolescents' educational aspirations through targeted change of modifiable environmental (background and family) and personal factors (Garg, R., Kauppi, C., Lewko, J., & Urajnik, D., 2002) ; confirmed about the great impact of family and school in shaping the young adult's career choice and the critical role played by parents in shaping career choice (Natalie, M.F., 2006) ; suggested that families played a significant role in shaping students' educational pathways and decisions (Michelle, A.R., 2013; Rajesh, V. R. & Chandrasekaran, V., 2014; Kathleen, M.J., 2001) and illustrated the importance of considering the social environment inclusive of family academic support which was found directly related to educational expectations (Wood, V.F. 2010). Studies on resilience in general and educational resilience in particular have typically revealed that there are several factors, which differ significantly between resilient and non-resilient students. Results of studies showed an existence of a strong relationship between productive coping and wellbeing and confirmed the fact that young people with good school experiences and subsequent connectedness were also likely to have positive wellbeing, which might have facilitated their use of helpful coping strategies (Frydenberg, E., Care, E., Freeman, E., & Chan, E., 2009). Riahi, M., Mohammadi, N., Norozi, R., & Malekitabar, M., (2015) observed that student beliefs about personal abilities to complete schoolwork successfully were better equipped with stress coping ability. There are multiple studies on these variables individually but researcher could not find a study combining these three variables. Therefore researcher selected this topic.

Statement of the Problem

A study of secondary school students' attitude towards education in relation to their educational aspirations and educational resilience.

Operational Definition of the Terms

Attitude towards Education

Attitude towards education is the degree to which the students view the usefulness and need of education in one's life.

Educational Aspirations

Educational aspirations means students' thoughts about their future after school education, their goals and their confidence in achieving those goals.

Educational Resilience

Educational Resilience is the degree to which students believe in their own ability to deal with problems and challenges that they face in their school settings

Aims of the Study

The broad aim is to study secondary school students' attitude towards education in relation to their educational aspirations and educational resilience.

Objectives of the Study

- 1) To compare secondary school students' attitude towards education, educational aspirations and educational resilience on the basis of gender.
- 2) To ascertain the relationship between secondary school students' attitude towards education and their educational aspirations.
- 3) To ascertain the relationship between secondary school students' attitude towards education and their educational resilience.

Hypotheses of the Study

- 1) There is no significant difference in secondary school students' attitude towards education, educational aspirations and educational resilience on the basis of gender.
- 2) There is no significant relationship between secondary school students' attitude towards education and their educational aspirations.
- 3) There is no significant relationship between secondary school students' attitude towards education and their educational resilience.

Design of the Study

Methodology of the Study

The descriptive method of causal comparative and correlational types was used in the present research.

Sampling Techniques

The incidental sampling technique was used by the researcher to collect data.

Tools used in Present Research

In the present study, the researcher used readymade tools for all the variables.

Attitude towards education scale was prepared by Thombare V. in 1993. The reliability coefficient was 0.73. Tool consists of total 17 statements (6 positive and 11 negative). Each statement was rated on 4 point scale i.e. strongly agree, agree, disagree, strongly disagree. Maximum and minimum possible score on this scale is 68 and 17 respectively.

Educational Aspirations scale was prepared by Shah G. in 2016. The reliability coefficient was 0.7. Tool consists of total 20 statements (16 positive and 4 negative). Each statement was rated on 5 point scale i.e. strongly agree, agree, undecided, disagree, strongly disagree. Maximum and minimum possible score on this scale is 100 and 20 respectively.


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Educational Resilience scale was prepared by Shah G. in 2016. The reliability coefficient was 0.63. Tool consists of total 13 statements (9 positive and 4 negative). Each statement was rated on 5 point scale i.e. strongly agree, agree, undecided, disagree, strongly disagree. Maximum and minimum possible score on this scale is 65 and 13 respectively.

Techniques of Data Analysis

Techniques of data analysis include descriptive and inferential data analysis.

Descriptive Data Analysis

The data collected was subjected to descriptive analysis in which Mean, Median, Mode, Standard Deviation, Skewness and Kurtosis were calculated.

- 1) There is no significant difference in secondary school students' attitude towards education, educational aspirations and educational resilience on the basis of gender.

The calculated values of 't' for attitude towards education, educational aspirations and educational resilience are 1.35, 1.13 and 0.76 respectively. Table values of 't' for 0.05 and 0.01 level are 1.98 and 2.63 respectively. All calculated values of 't' are less than table values of 't', therefore we can say that there is no significant difference in secondary school students' attitude towards education, educational aspirations and educational resilience on the basis of gender.

- 2) There is significant relationship between secondary school students' attitude towards education and their educational aspirations.

- 3) There is significant relationship between secondary school students' attitude towards education and their educational resilience.

The 'r's between attitude towards education and educational resilience of boys, girls and total students are 0.37, 0.39 and 0.4 respectively. All these 'r's are positive and significant.

Discussions and Conclusion

Present study revealed that there is no significant difference in secondary school students' attitude towards education, educational aspirations and educational resilience on the basis of gender. Which means both boys and girls considers investment in education worthwhile because it is required for a successful life. For them education is a tool for sharpening the innate intelligence of an individual. Both boys and girls have high goals and expectation from themselves, as a result they are more goal oriented and they take each challenge as a learning experience.

There is significant positive relationship between secondary school students' attitude towards education and their educational aspirations. This means students with high educational aspirations will have favourable attitude towards education and vice versa. If students have more positive thoughts about their future, goals which they set for themselves and their confidence in achieving those goals then they tend to have positive attitude towards education.

There is significant positive relationship between secondary school students' attitude towards education and their educational resilience. This means students with high educational resilience will have favourable attitude towards education and vice versa. If students strongly believe in their own ability to deal with problems and challenges at their school level then will lead a successful life and will have a favorable attitude towards education.

Results of the present study are very important for students, parents, teachers and principals of schools. It is very imperative for students to have high levels of educational aspirations and resilience. For this parents, teachers and principals of schools can make sure that students get all positive experiences which are desirable to develop high levels of educational aspirations and resilience. In this regard, schools must focus on overall development of students rather than only intellectual aspect by offering diversified programmes which provide opportunities to students not only to learn school subjects but much beyond that.
