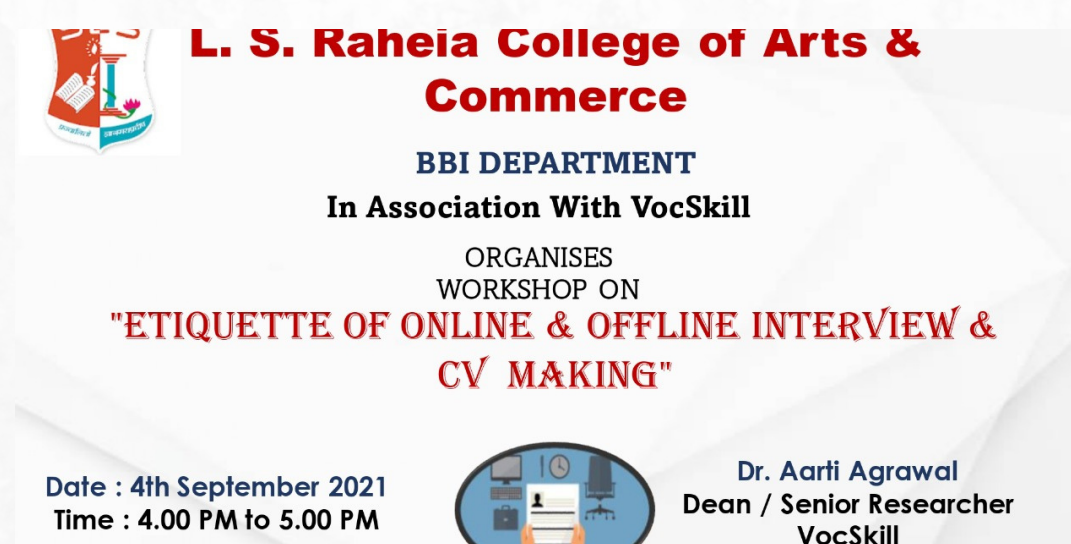




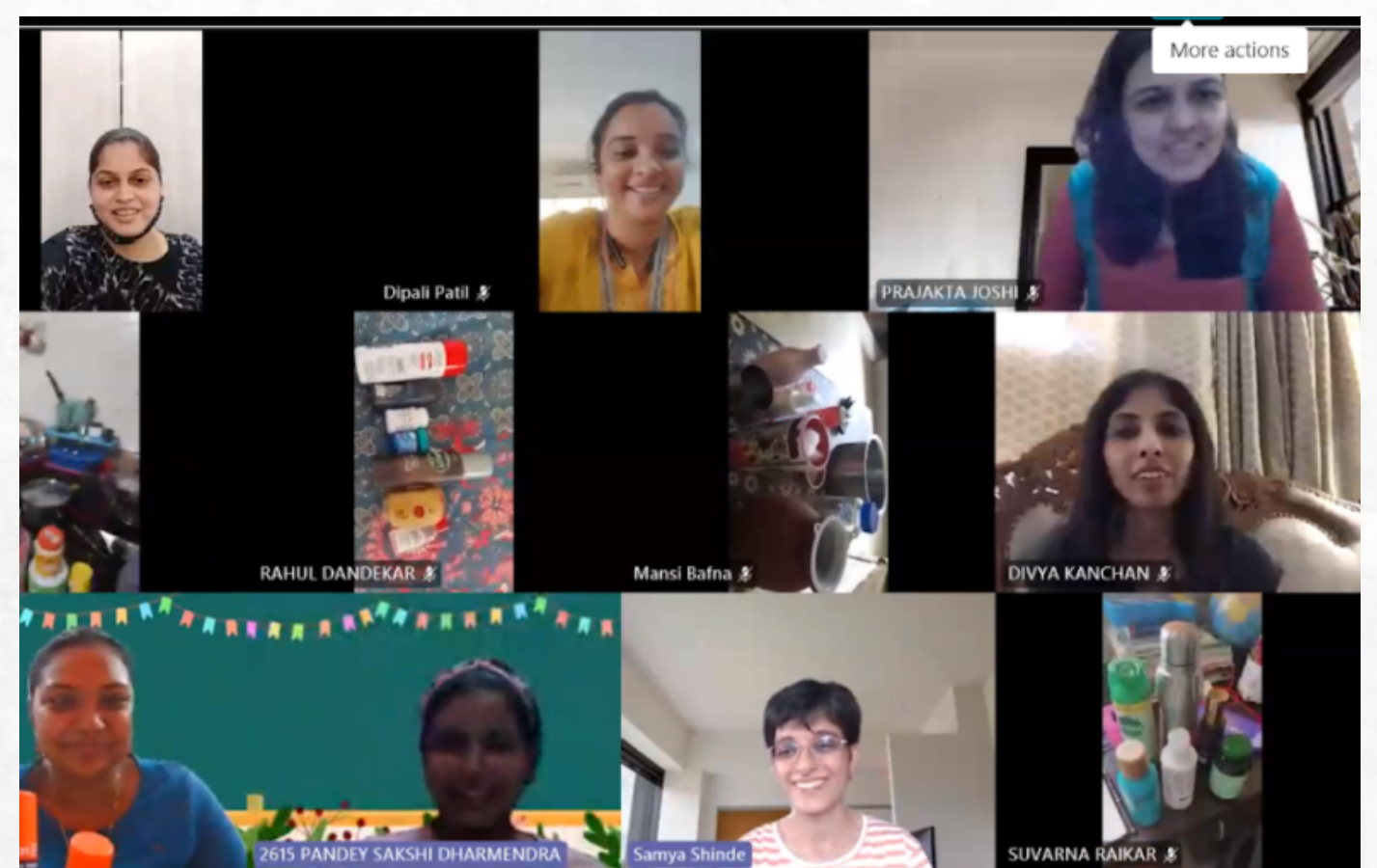
## Etiquette of Online & Offline Interview & C.V. Making Workshop

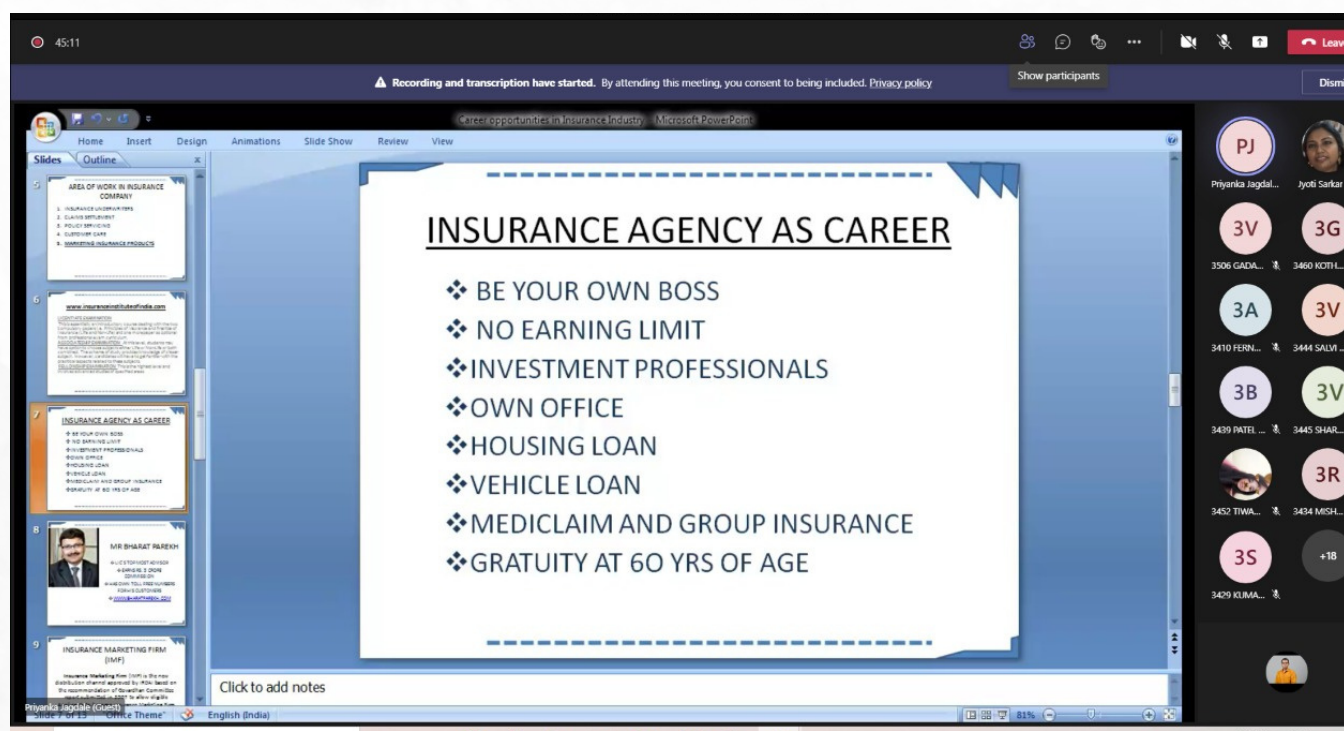


## Brand Mania

The fun filled quiz on Brand Awareness and advertising was conducted on the 7th of September, 2021 by the Department of Commerce. The exciting event garnered 42 participants

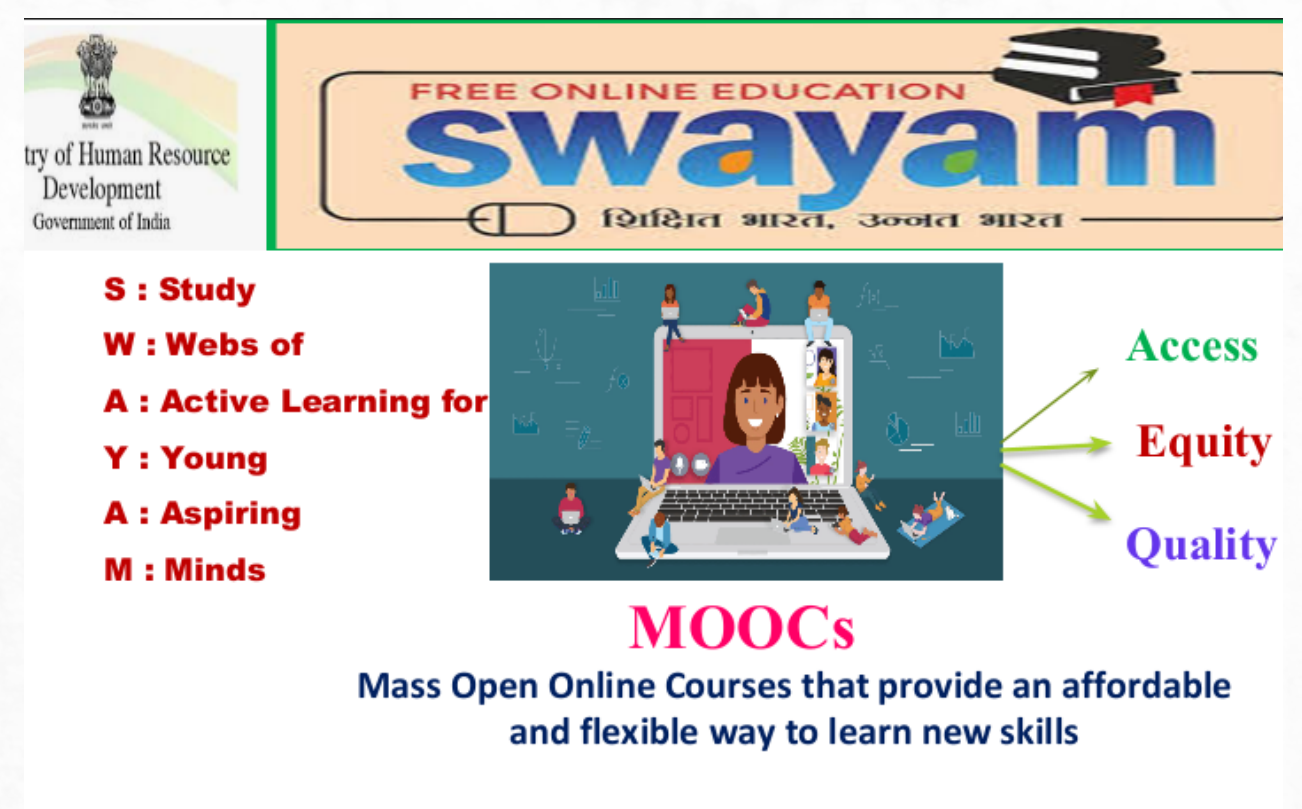
## Webinar on 'Career Opportunities in Insurance Sector'

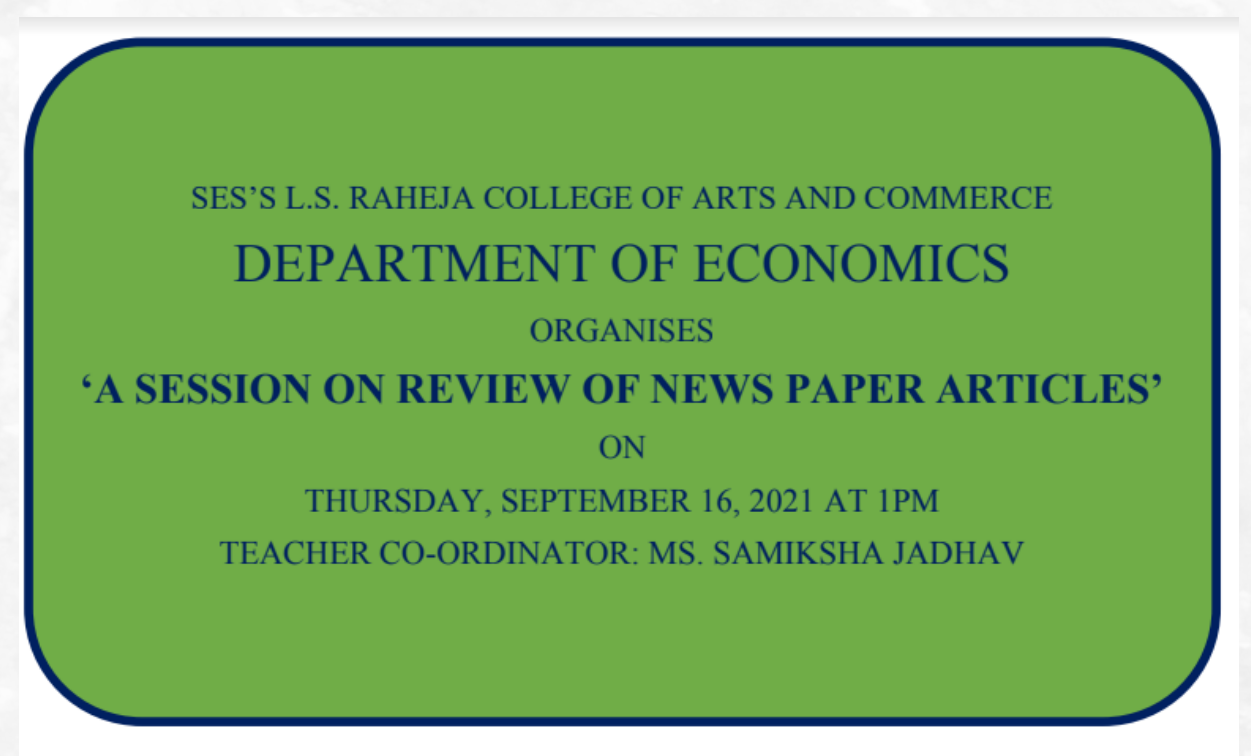


## Online PPT Presentation Competition


## A Session on Review of Newspaper Articles

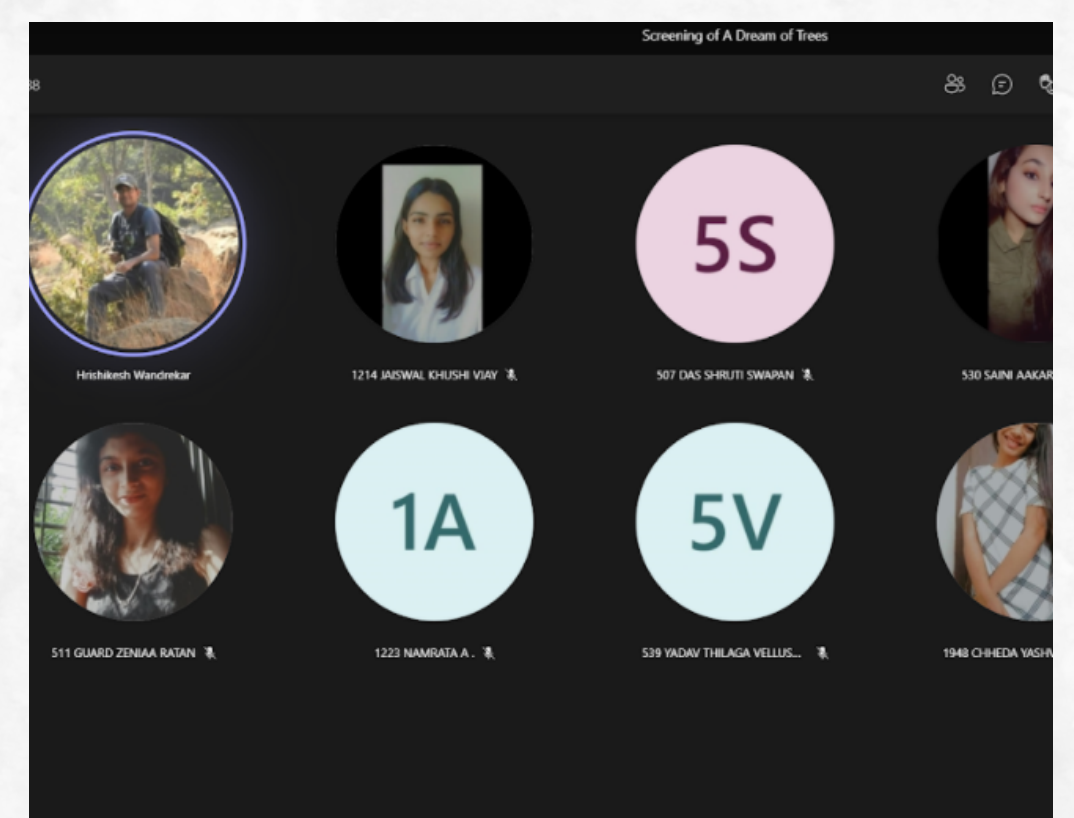

## Telling a Data Story - Webinar

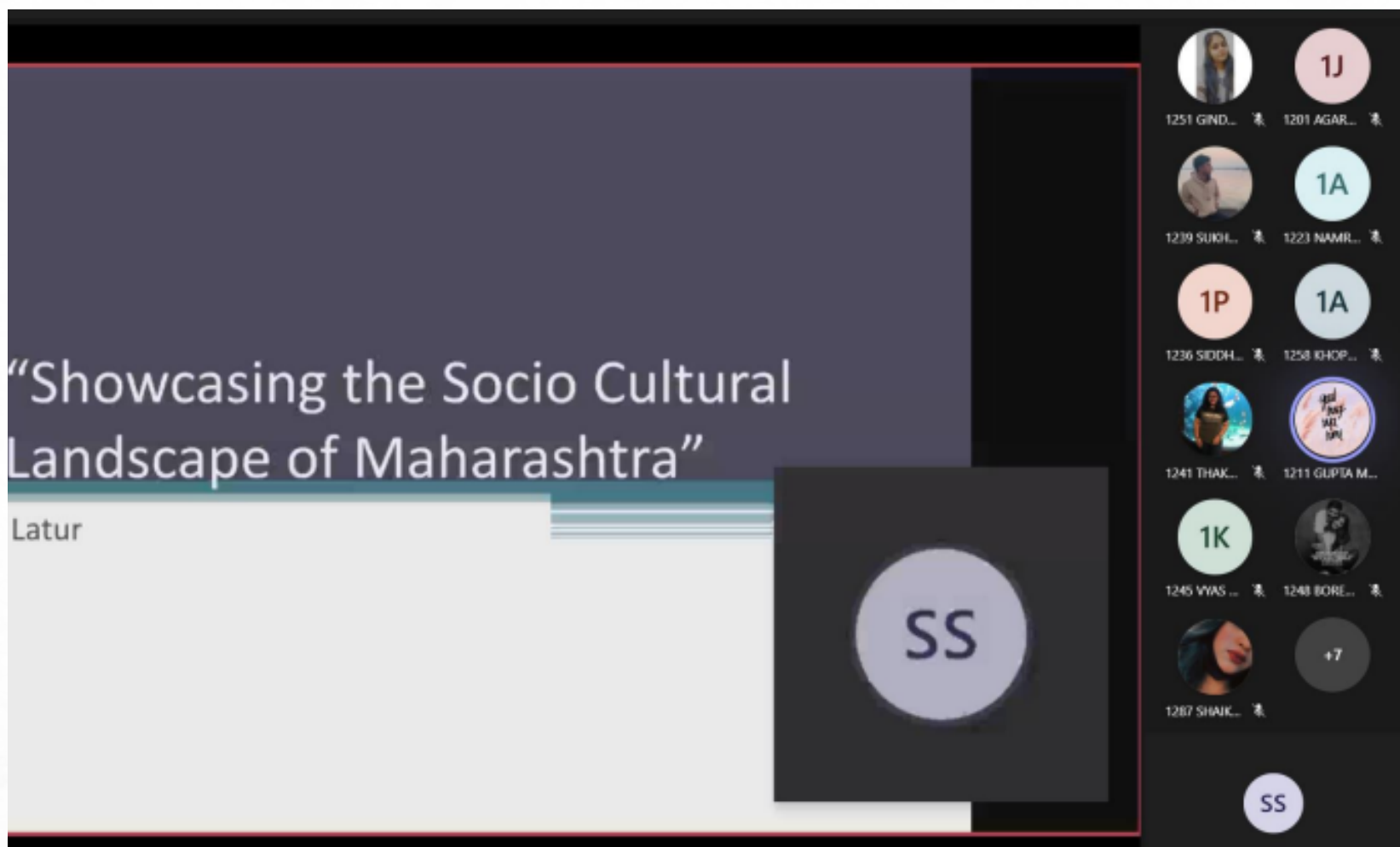

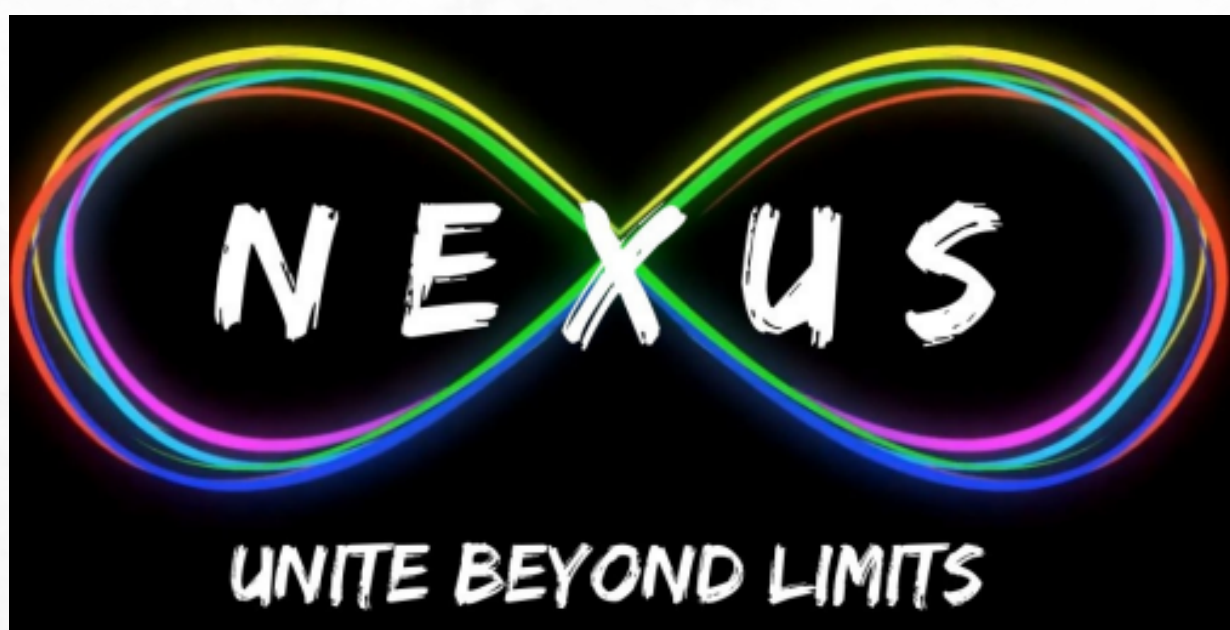


# The Use of E-Resources of N-LIST, NDLI, EBSCO for Teaching Learning and Research

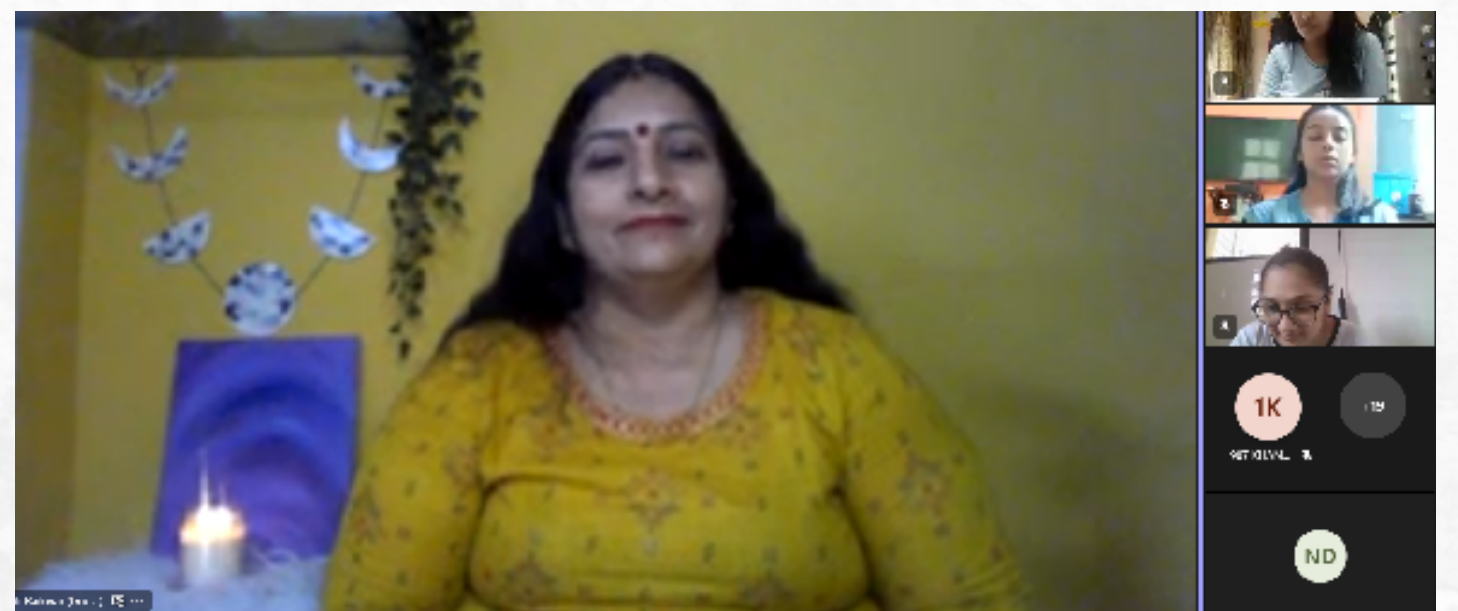
## Nexus



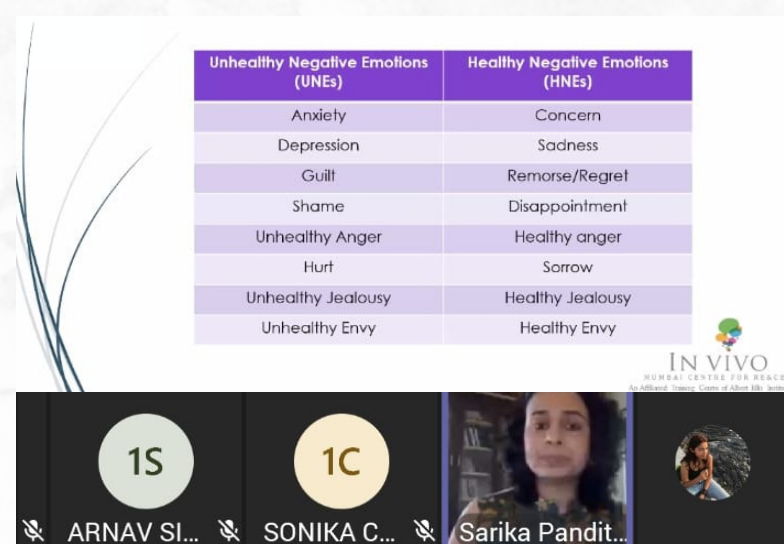

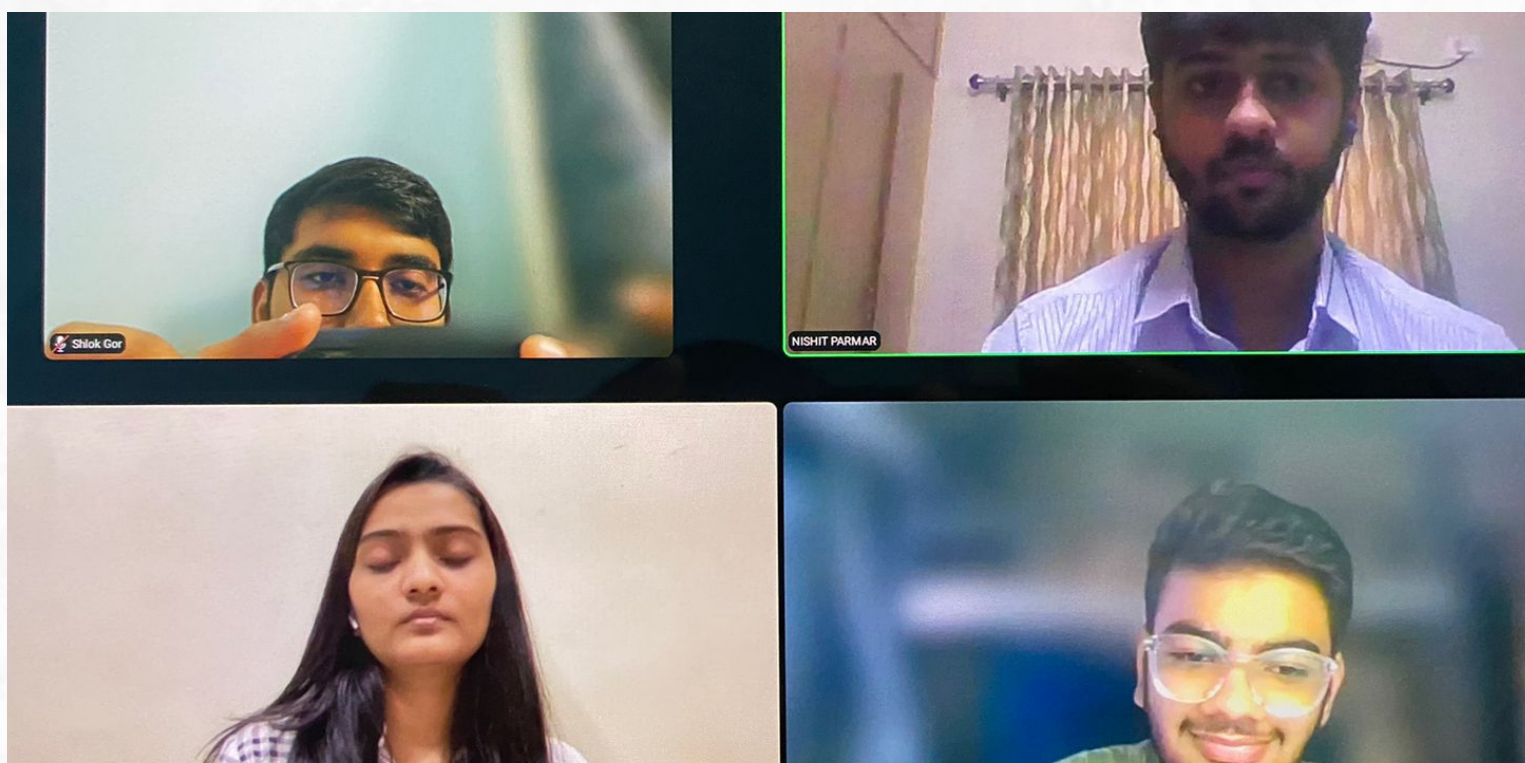

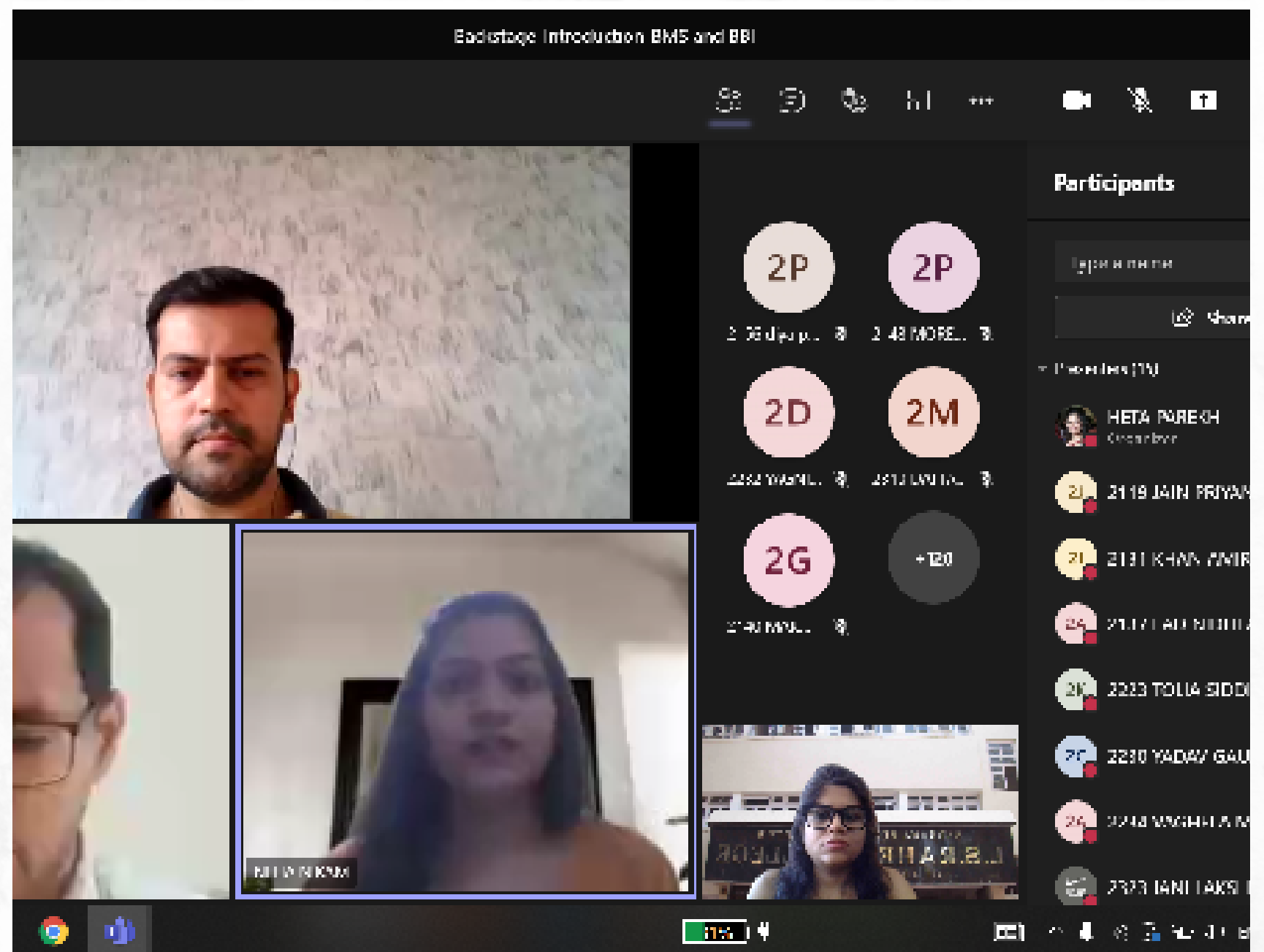
## NLP Change Workshop

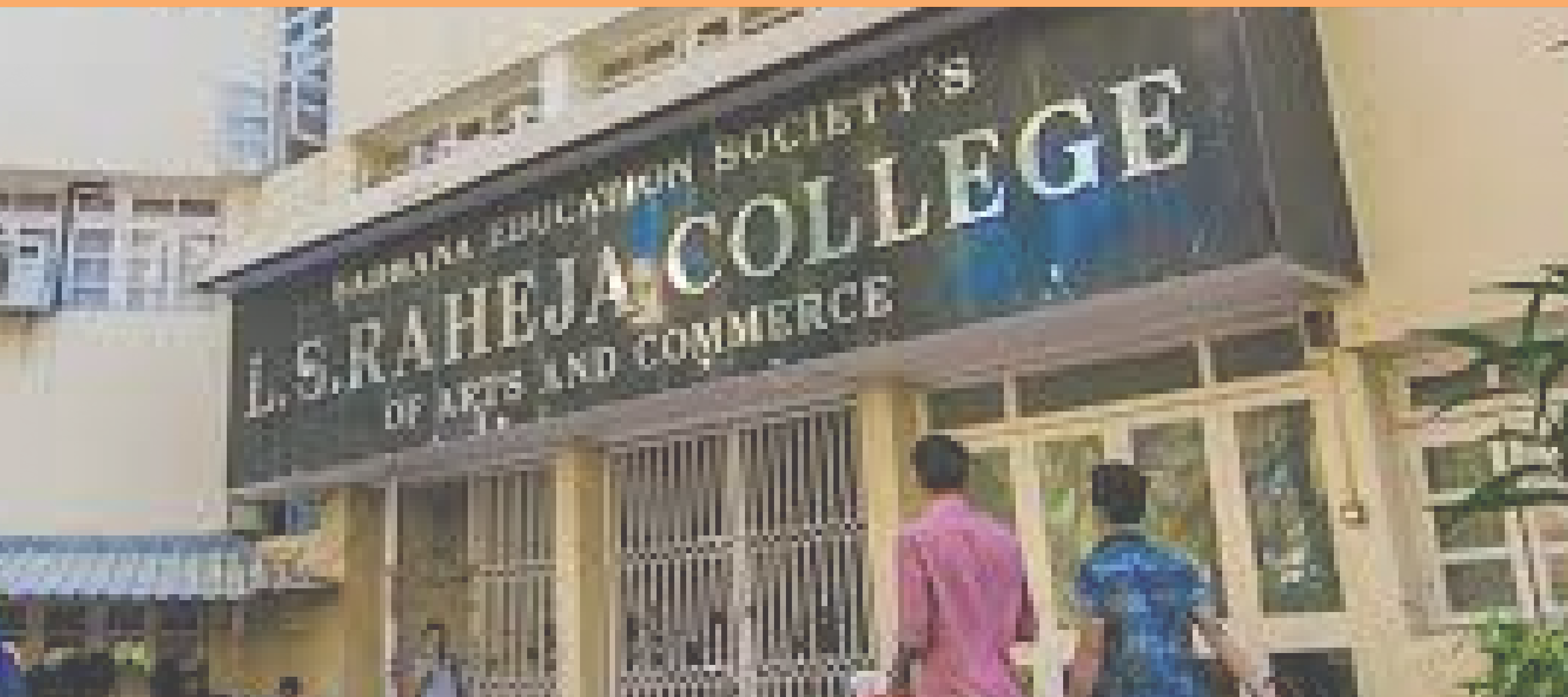
## Introduction to Backstage App - Webinar
