


## **Street Play - World AIDS** Day

#### **Doodle Poster Making Competition for World Literacy Day**




#### **Guest Lectures on 'IT Recruitment Process - An Overview'**




## **Workshops on Suicide** Prevention




#### **Harmonizing your Fitness Story**


## Online PPT (Project) Presentation Competition


## Raheja Week
