Library uses Calibre E-Book Management open-source software to manage its E-Books. With help of Calibre, Library users have 24 x 7 access to the e-books, rare books and books from open source.

E-Journals Management:

- **EBSCO E-Journals:** Library has subscribed EBSCO e-Journals, which is linked with library website. This can be remotely accessed by the students and the staff through their personal login id and password.
- UGCINFONET-NLIST: Library has got the membership of UGCINFONET-NLIST PROGRAM through which the faculty and students can access the number of ejournals and e-books. Library organized webinar on use of E-resources for Teaching, Learning and Research

Best Practices:

- User Orientation: Library conducts User Orientation program every year in the month of June to acquaint the new students in understanding the services the library provides them. For 2021-22 the user orientation was conducted on MS TEAM.
- In-service Program: For motivating staff to enhance their skill and expertise in conventional and e-library associated services and operations, the Library conducts an In-service program in the month of November every year.
- Book Bank Scheme: The College library has got a UGC grant of Rs.90000/- under the xth Five Year Plan for library books. The library has started the Book Bank scheme for the poor and needy students statistics for same is as below:

- **Wi-Fi Facility**: Library has 51 Mbps W-Fi internet connectivity Wi-Fi facility are provided free of charge.
- **Project Room:** Library has fully air conditioned Project room with 10 computers with Wi-Fi connectivity. In project room students can use subscribed as well as eresources and can prepare projects and also can have group study.
- External Membership: Malti Jayant Library has started External Membership for Alumina students and students of nearby areas for further studies. As a consequence, to be able to generate financial resources and there by supplement the money received by the library to provide additional user services.
- User feedback practice through different formats: User feedback is collected on all aspects of library services formally through suggestion box and feedback forms.
 Necessary action is then initiated and users are kept informed.

- Senior Citizen Book Club: Malti Jayant Dalal Library have a senior citizen book club this service is provided free of cost. Total Members are 26.
- Digitization of Question Papers and Library circulars: Library has digitized Question Papers from October2005 and Library Circulars for various departments from 2000 for speedy and easy access through intranet services, which is available for access on computers of library through intranet services. In 2020-21 library digitized circulars of University of Mumbai from 2013-14 till date and circulars of Maharashtra government for Higher Education form 1992 to till date.
- Open Access System: From academic year 2009-10 Library has started Open Access system. Open Access system helps the library to make students aware of available resources, optimum utilization of resources and for inculcating reading habits.
- WEBOPAC: From academic year 2010-11 Library has started WEBOPAC service. The
 library has linked the library catalog on the web, so the users can search the required
 information by connecting to uniform Resource Locator(URL) of WEBOPAC anytime
 during the day and from anywhere in the world. Thus WEBOPAC not only offer
 simplified access to library holdings for end-users but also enable librarians to add
 value to their catalogue data. In 2020-21 WEBOPAC was linked with library website
- **Dedicated Library Website**: WEBOPAC, e-resources, Institutional repositories, library collections, services and activities are linked with library website
- **1. Remote Access to E-Resources:** Open E-resources, E-resources of N-LIST, NDLI & EBSO E-Journals are linked with library website for remote Access.
- 2. Digital Institutional Repository: Library has Institutional repository which consists of past years question papers, syllabus, teachers' publications & government circulars). Institutional repository is linked to the library website.
- **3. Digital Achieves :** Library has digital archival collection under following categories, which are linked with library website.

- Government of Maharashtra G.R. for Higher Education from 1992-93
- **4. Library Blog:** Library has developed library blog to provide information about free resources, competitive exams and job alerts.
- 5. E-Alert Services/Digital Services: The Library's digital services have brought a new richness to our for students, through implementation of new E-Alert services. Library offered E-Alert services giving the information about notification of examination dates of competitive exams and opening of jobs in public and private sectors. . At

present nearly 260 students have enrolled for this service. During COVID -19 Lockdown, virtual and Online Book Exhibition was also organized.

- 6. Membership of National Digital Library: The library enlightened the students about the resources and services of National Digital Library. The library made nearly 400 students and teaching and non-teaching staff a member of National Digital Library. Library has also registered for NDLI CLUB.
