DHARAVI: A HEAVEN FOR ILLITERATE MIGRANTS & THE POORS

15 April, 2017.

The trip to Dharavi organized by department of Sociology of L.S. Raheja college of Arts & Commerce started from Mahim station around 2 pm with Prof. Samya Shinde & Prof. Anagha with 8 SYBA students.

We were guided by MR. Revansiddhu who took us to various industries, factories, lanes, bylanes, etc. of Dharavi, Thus changing our perception about Dharavi from crime oriented place, disorganized settings & misbehaving locals to an important financial centre with most kind hearted inhabitants.

First we went to 'Nal Bazaar' where clothes were recycled. The printing industry where designs on clothes were printed had machines imported from China. We were explained that there are two types of printing: Offset printing & Screen printing. The leather tannery made leather for industrial uses only. The leathers were made from buffalo skins.

It can be observed that the population of Dharavi mostly consists of migrants from all over India looking for jobs in small scale industries. Hindus are in majority and Tamil speaking people are in large number. The literacy rate among people is very low and the dropout rates of girls are high. Very few schools and colleges can be found in Dharavi. Even the hospitals are less. However we can find very large number of small clinics in the vicinity. Most of them belong to Ayurvedic techniques. We found 12 temples, 3 churches and very few mosques in the vicinity. Attention towards sanitation were not at all paid because we saw only two toilets there and most of the men and children opted for open defecation.

One can find large number of small scale industries with poor working conditions. The rooms are very small, it includes their working as well as living place, their workplace has no windows, no protective gears are provided to the workers, the room temperature is extremely high, e.g. : In cloth dyeing industry, the temperature required to dye is around 60 degrees to 80 degrees. Many of the raw materials are transformed into finished goods where they are exported to the foreign countries and then again the same goods are imported and sold in Indian towns. Most of the goods are made in homes like pouches, printing blocks, papad, etc.

The houses are too small and the family members living in the houses are quite large in number. The redevelopment programmers of Dharavi are still going on.

It can be concluded that if anything happens to the small scale industries of Dharavi, it would not only affect Indian economy extensively but also foreign investments and markets.
