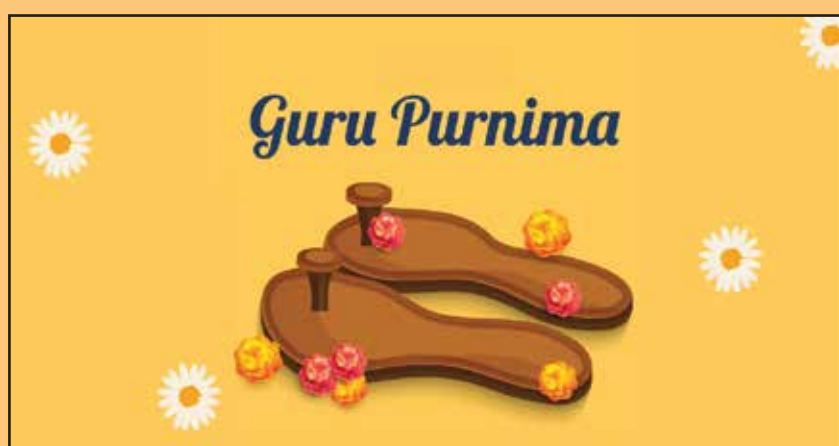
Library Organizes Guest Lecture On “Proposed Scheme Of Education And Training”
