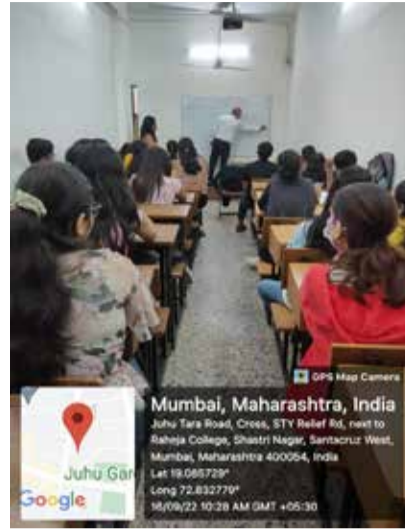
World Indigenous Day Tribal Poster Making Competition

On the evening of Monday 19th September 2022, the Department of BFM organised a fresher's party for their first year students in the college auditorium.

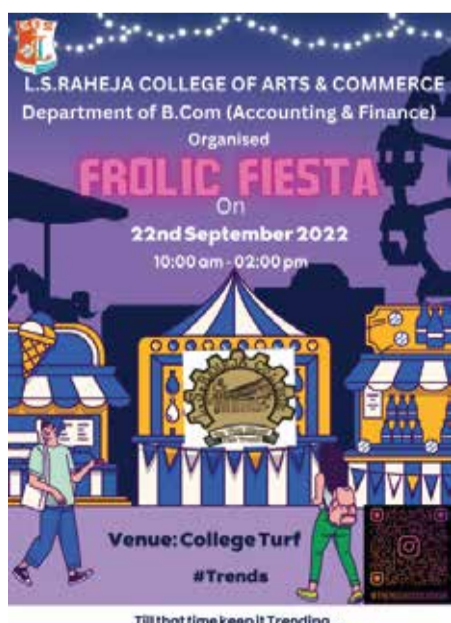
Warli Book Mark Making Activity

Rebuttal Rebels



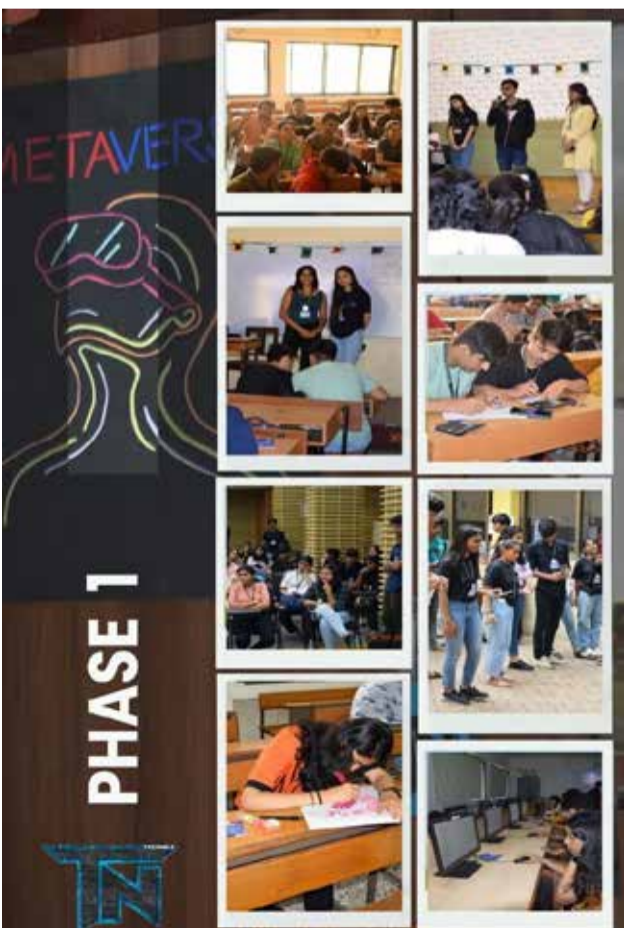


Garba

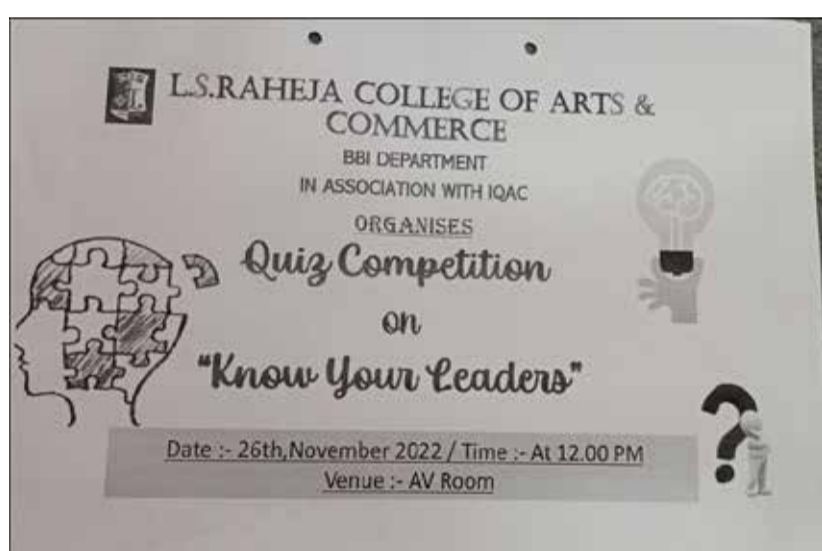
Parent's Teacher meeting for FYBBI
