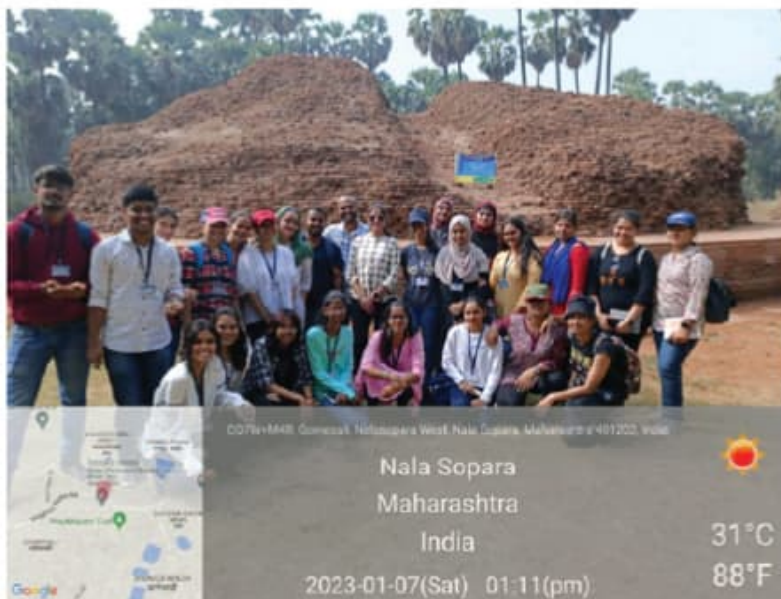
Museum on Wheels at L. S. Raheja Campus

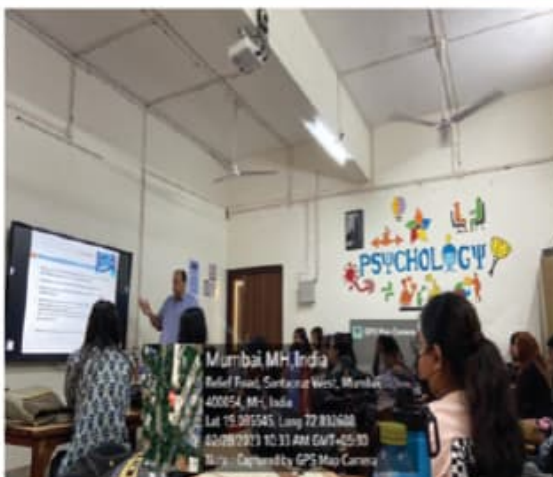
Psychology students visit Heart to Heart counselling centre
